There are many areas of the 'Remote Education Support' within the DfE guidance. We are committed to:

- 🛡️ planning a programme that is of equivalent length and quality, to the core teaching pupils would receive in school, ideally including daily contact with teachers/teacher led sessions/
- 🛡️ using high-quality online/offline resources
- 🛡️ using online tools consistently, across all classes
- 🛡️ providing printed resources/textbooks/workbooks for pupils without online access
- 🛡️ providing all pupils with an exercise book in which to complete some of their work
- 🛡️ providing meaningful and ambitious daily work, within a number of different subjects
- 🛡️ providing clear explanations delivered by a teacher or through a high-quality video/resource
- 🛡️ providing high-quality verbal or written feedback (via the online platform)
- 🛡️ adjusting pace or difficulty in response to questions and ongoing assessment
- 🛡️ avoiding an overreliance on long-term projects or internet research activities

### When will we provide remote learning?

- 🛡️ Remote learning will be provided: '***where a class, group or small number of pupils need to self-isolate, or there is a local lockdown requiring children to stay at home***' (DfE)

### When will we not provide remote learning?

- 🛡️ When individuals are ill, either with Covid-19 or any other unrelated illness

### What if a staff member is ill?


- 🛡️ Another member of staff will ensure remote learning is still provided to the class whose teacher is ill

### What if a family or staff member has internet issues?

- 🛡️ In this instance, class teachers will contact families by phone once a week
- 🛡️ Another staff member would ensure remote learning is provided

### How will we ensure online safety?

- 🛡️ Staff complete statutory online safety training
- 🛡️ E-safety lessons are provided for all pupils
- 🛡️ Parents receive guidance for the online 'platform'
